





Modern Slavery Statement

As Tradeslink is a recruitment business, the Company acknowledges its responsibility to the Modern Slavery Act 2015. It will not support or deal with any business knowingly involved in slavery or human trafficking. All operatives engaged are given a choice to work through an Umbrella Company, In-house PAYE, Self Employed or via their own Limited Company and can leave an assignment on their own accord.

Tradeslink has a zero-tolerance approach towards slavery, and human trafficking within its own business and only deals with suppliers and clients who share the same commitment ensuring all of its supply chain ethically conducts business.

The Directors and Senior Management shall take responsibility for implementing this statement and shall provide adequate training and investment to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place within the organisation and its supply chains.

The Directors and Senior Management shall periodically review the company procedures to maintain the zero-tolerance approach towards slavery and human trafficking. The Company Directors will also review and update this statement on an annual basis.
